SUBJECT: PROPOSED REVISIONS TO 2010/11 SCHOOL CALENDAR

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On Wednesday, March 31, 2010, Capistrano Unified School District Board of Trustees passed Resolution 0910-60, "Resolution to Implement Changes in the Terms and Conditions of the Certificated Bargaining Unit." Under the terms of this resolution, the Board implemented a four day (three instructional and one non-instructional) reduction in the 2009-10 certificated work year and a five day reduction (two instructional and three non-instructional) in the 2010-2011 certificated work year. The resolution designated May 28, 2010 and June 24, 2010 as two of these days and directed the remaining days to be agreed upon by April 30, 2010.

At the direction of the Superintendent, the district Calendar Committee met to consider revisions to the 2009/10 and 2010/11 school calendars. This standing committee consists of representatives of CUEA, CSEA, Teamsters, CUMA, and PTSA. Representatives from all of these groups except CUEA and Teamsters were present at the meeting held on Wednesday, April 14, 2010. The 2009/10 days were approved by the Board on Friday, April 16, 2010.

CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS

This Board item presents for Board consideration the proposed revision to the 2010/11 (Exhibit A) school calendar. These proposed revisions have been selected on their ability to minimize disruptions to the flow of instruction.

2010/11 School Year Recommendation

The committee recommends the reduction in calendar be accomplished in the following manner:

The committee recommends that students begin school one day later than previously scheduled. In this proposal, the first student school day is Wednesday, September 8, 2010.

In addition, the elimination of one teacher pre-service day is recommended. The first work day for teachers would be Tuesday, September 7, 2010.

The committee further recommends that Thursday, February 17, 2011 be a non-student/non-teacher day. Historically, this day has one of the highest absence rates during the year.

Additionally, Monday, November 1, which is currently an elementary parent conference day and a secondary professional growth day, and Friday, June 24, the day after students' last day, are recommended to be non-work days.

The furlough days are as follows:

Non-instructional days: September 2, 2010, November 1, 2010, June 24, 2011

Instructional days: September 7, 2010, February 17, 2010

These furlough days will result in the following changes to the 2010-11 school calendar:

Tuesday, September 7 – Returning teachers begin work

Wednesday, September 8 - Students return to school

Monday, November 1 – Non-student/non-teacher day

Thursday, February 17, 2011 - Non-student/non-teacher day

Friday, June 24 – Non-work day for teachers

Changes to the calendar (Exhibit A) are in bold italics.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Adoption of this calendar will result in a reduction to the paid work year for teachers. The estimated \$5.2 million savings associated with the elimination of these days from the calendar was calculated and recognized as part of the Resolution to Implement Changes in the Terms and Conditions of Employment of the Certificate Bargaining Unit approved by Trustees on March 31, 2010.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully requested the Board approve the proposed school calendar the revisions to the 2010/11 (Exhibit A) calendar.
