All presentations shall be heard by the County Committee prior to the formal discussion of the agenda topic under consideration. Once the agenda item has been opened for public comment, no additional "Request to Address the County Committee" cards shall be accepted for that topic.

Proposed Public Hearing Guidelines

Speakers for public comments regarding items on the County Committee Agenda should observe the following guidelines:

Public comments will not exceed three minutes per person and will not exceed 1 hour in total. The County Committee may limit the amount of time each individual has to speak based on the amount of people who sign-up to speak. For example, if 30 people sign-up to speak, each person will be limited to 2 minutes (60 minutes / 30 people = 2 minutes)

Public comment cards to speak on an agenda item will NOT be accepted after that specific agenda item has been opened for discussion.

These ***Public Hearing Guidelines*** may be changed or suspended for a specific period of time by a majority vote of the County Committee.
