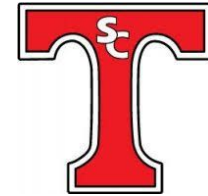
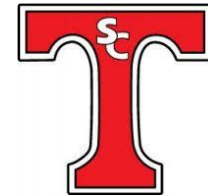


Sand Volleyball and the Capistrano Unified School District



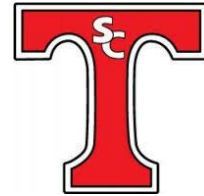
Purpose:

To work with the CUSD, Parents, and Community members to develop plans to create Sand Volleyball facilities at all CUSD High School sites.



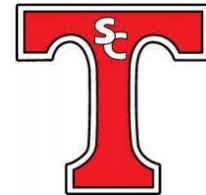
Why Sand Volleyball?

Sand Volleyball is one of the fastest growing sports in the country.

According to the Sporting Goods Manufacturer's Association, participation in Sand Volleyball grew 7.9% in 2007-08. It has grown 25.8% since 2016.

Per the Sports & Fitness Industry Association (SFIA) research, youth female participation - ages 6-24 – in beach volleyball has increased by 47%, 467,000 since 2007.

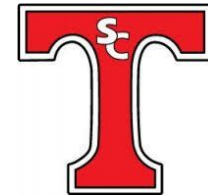
USA Volleyball tournament participation up 48%. CBVA will hold nearly 1000 tournaments this year.

- Roster Spots - 1410



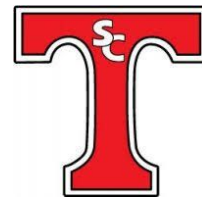
NCAA I,II,III, NAIA, & CCCAA Growth...

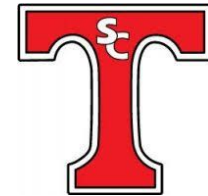
Why **WE** should do this...
