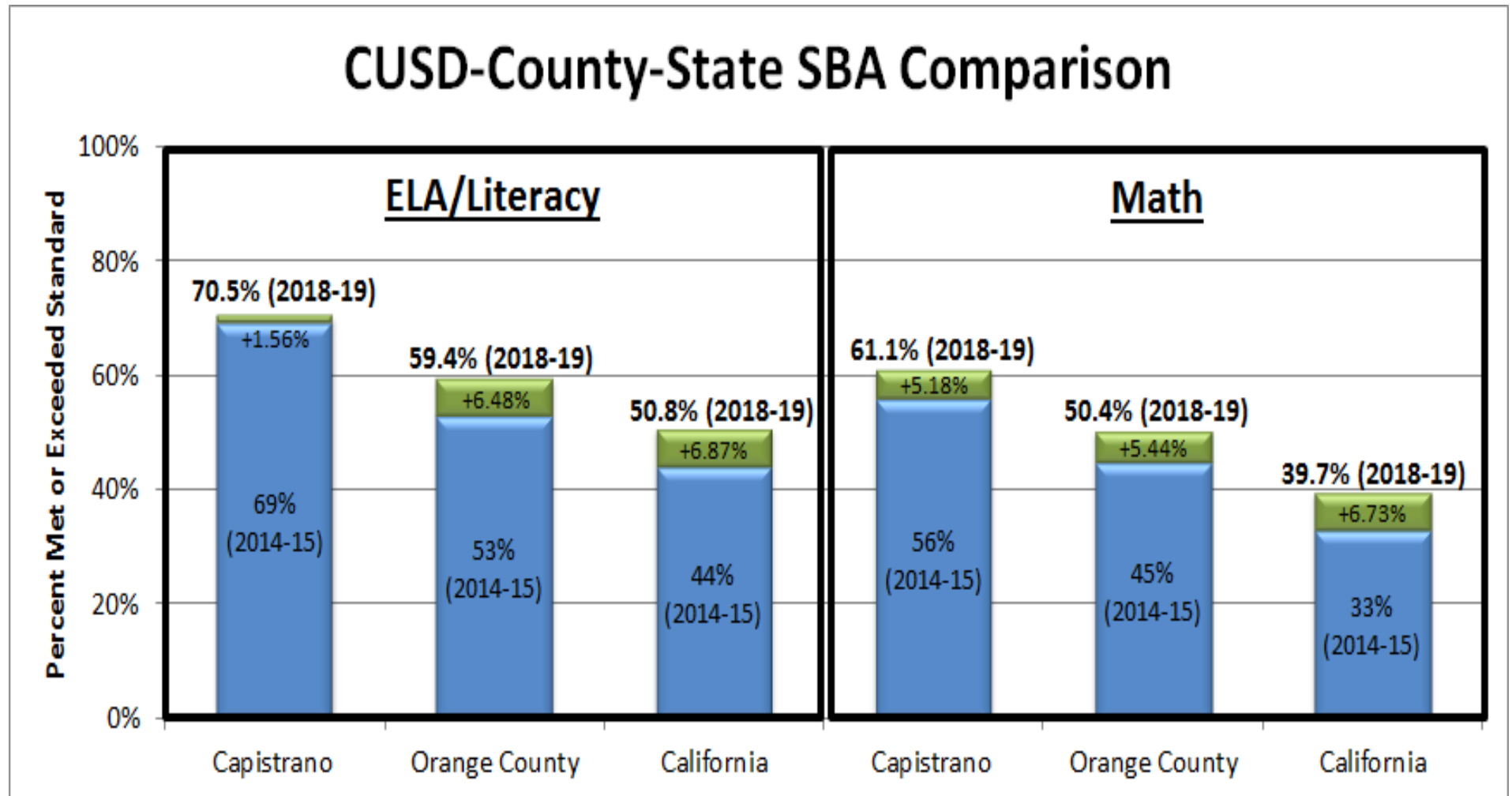
# SBA Refresher

- Based on California State Standards and tests ELA/Literacy and Math
- Measures College and Career Readiness
- Tests students in grade 3-8 and 11
- Consists of Computer-Adaptive Test (CAT) and Performance Task (PT)

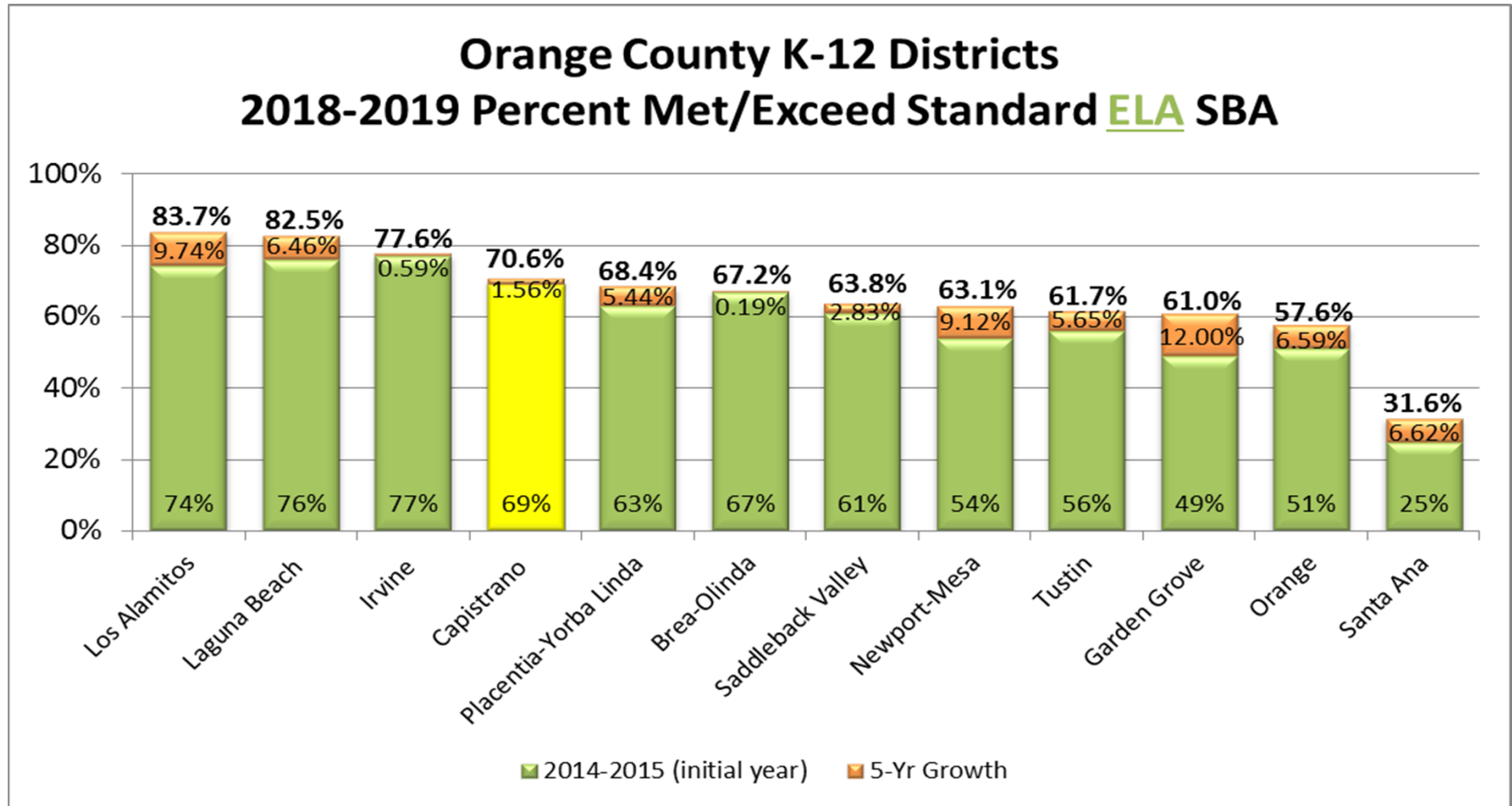
# SBA Refresher-Achievement Results

  - Standard Not Met (1)

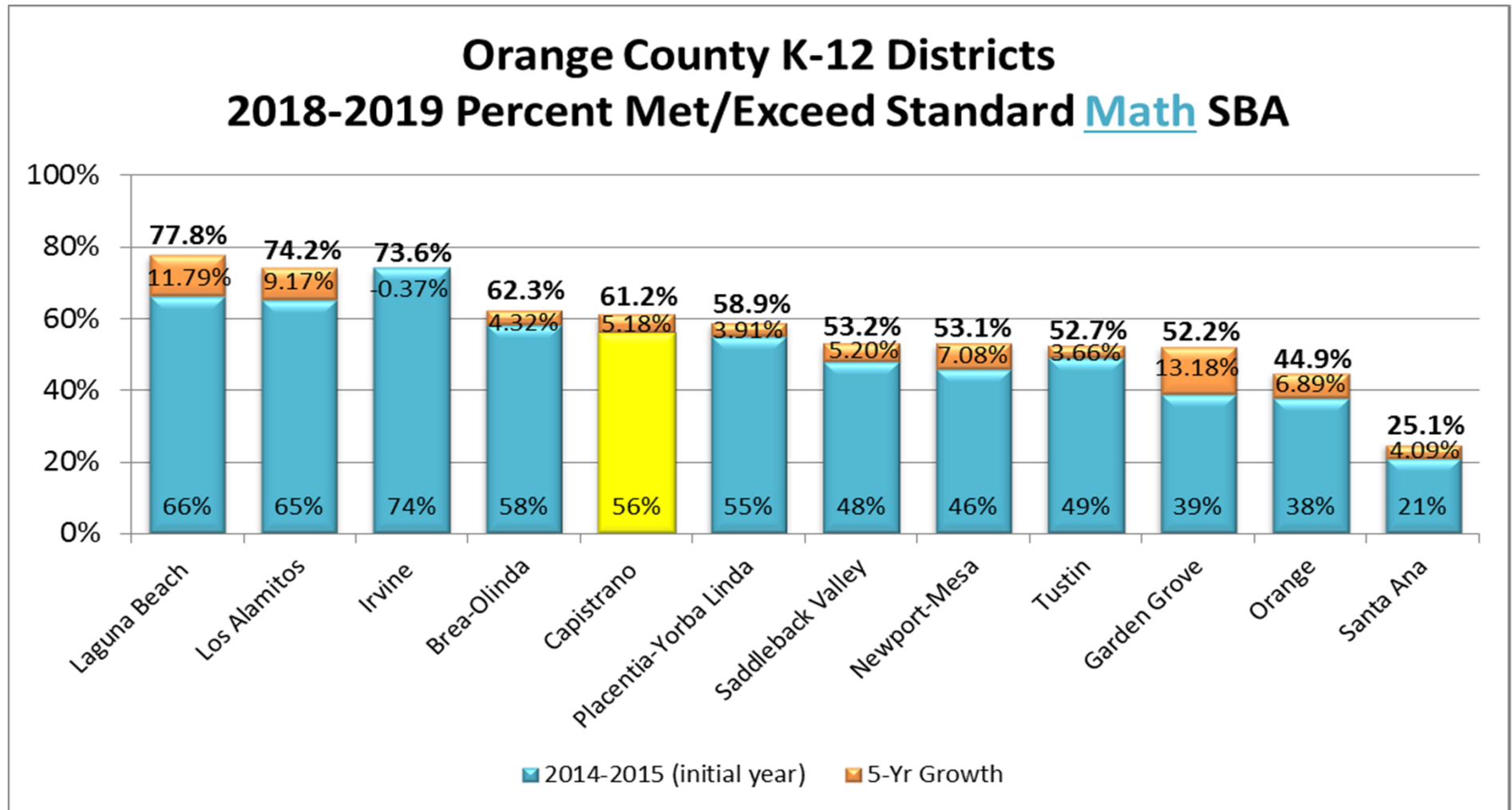
# District-County-State Comparison

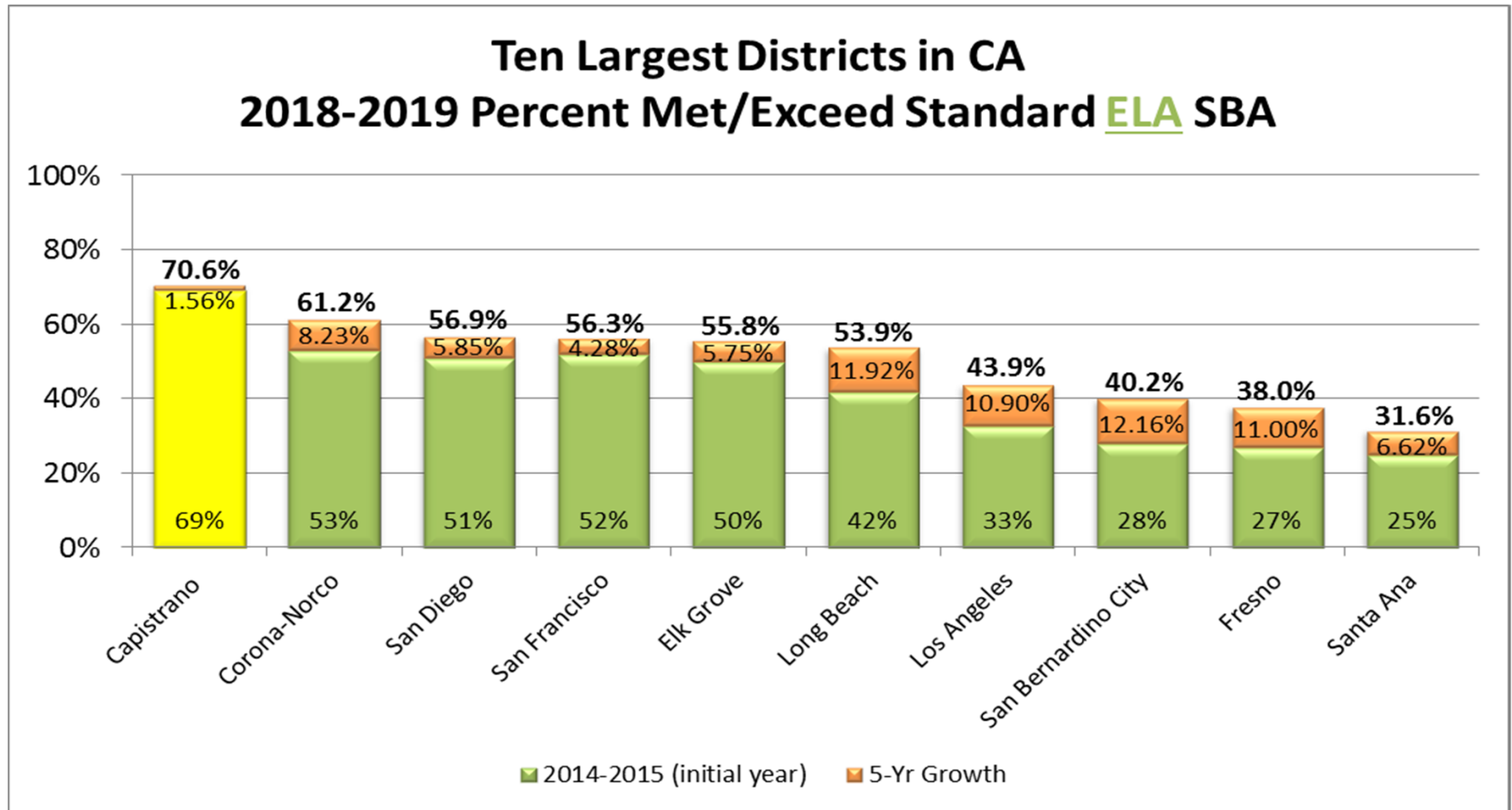

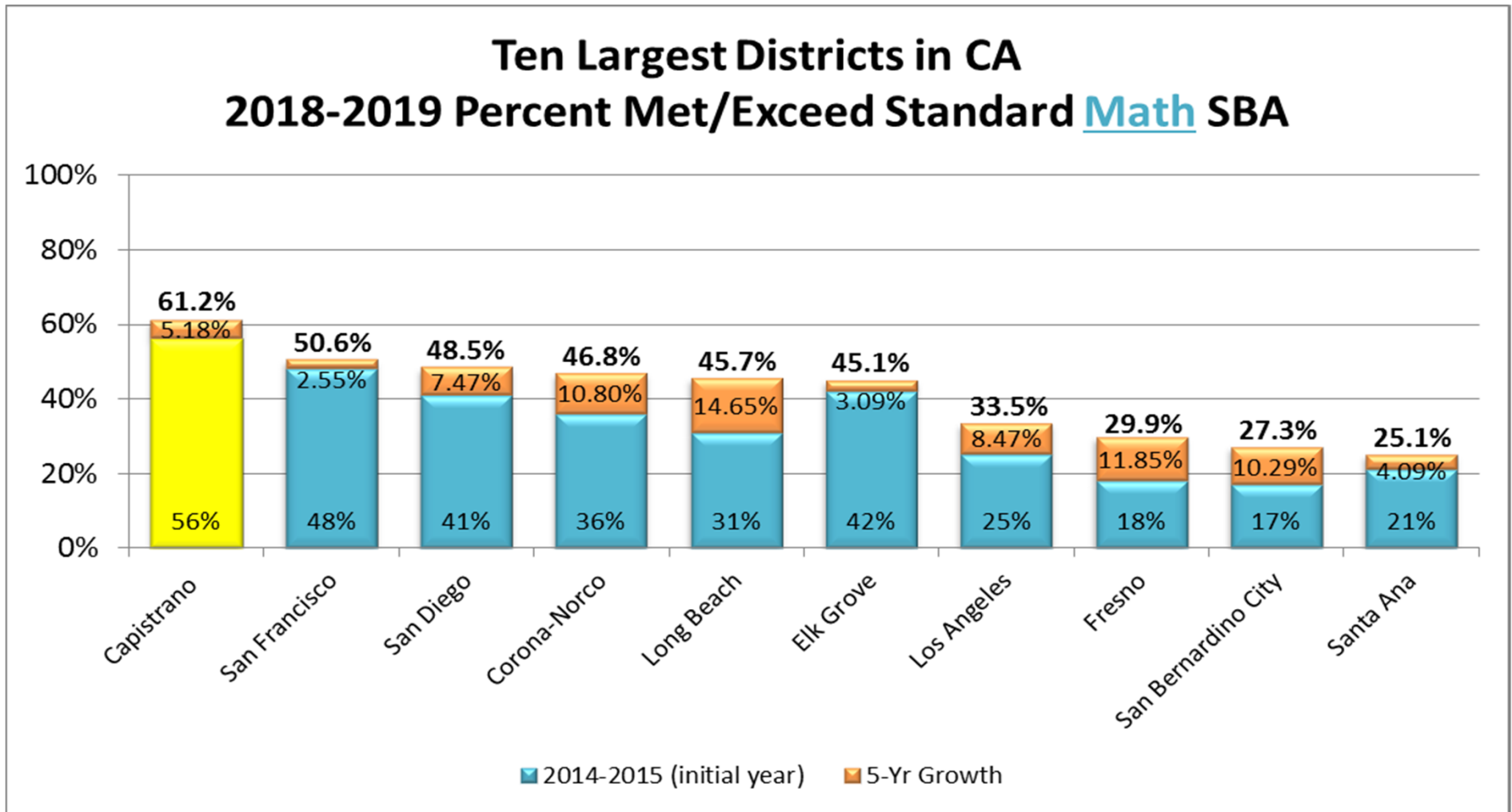

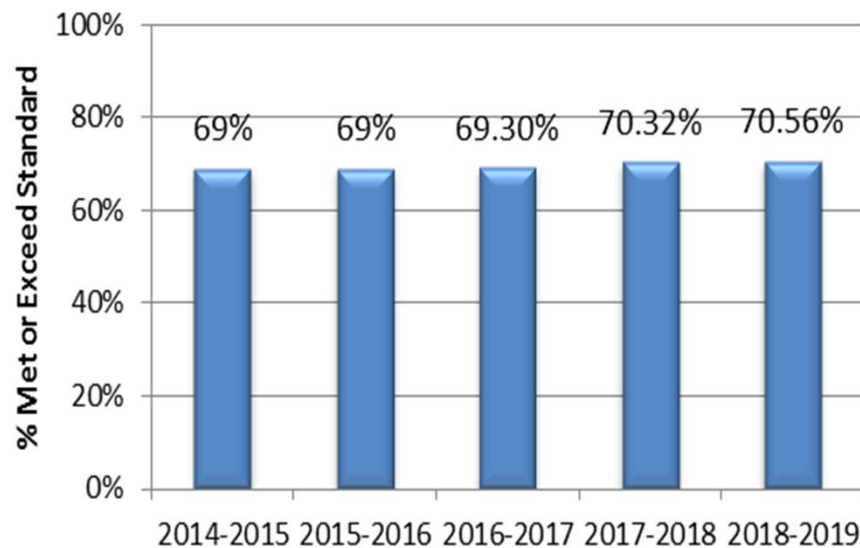
# SBA Achievement Results – Demographics Context\*

  - 2,900 students with disabilities

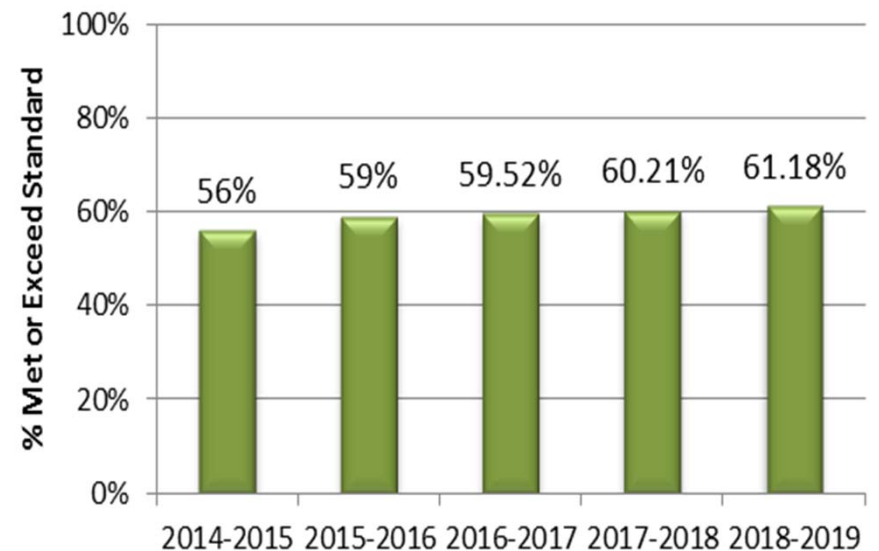

## ELA SBA - All Students

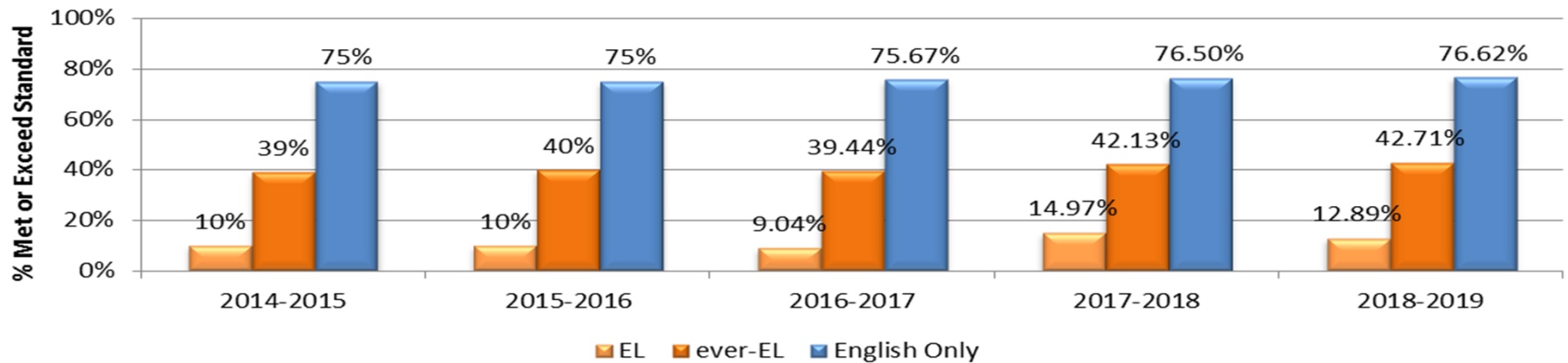

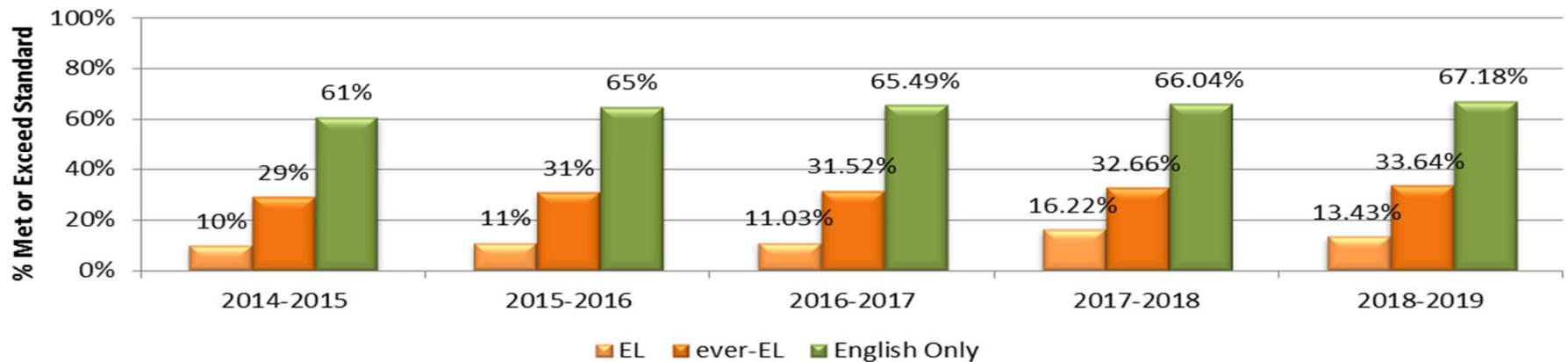

## ELA SBA - EL Comparison

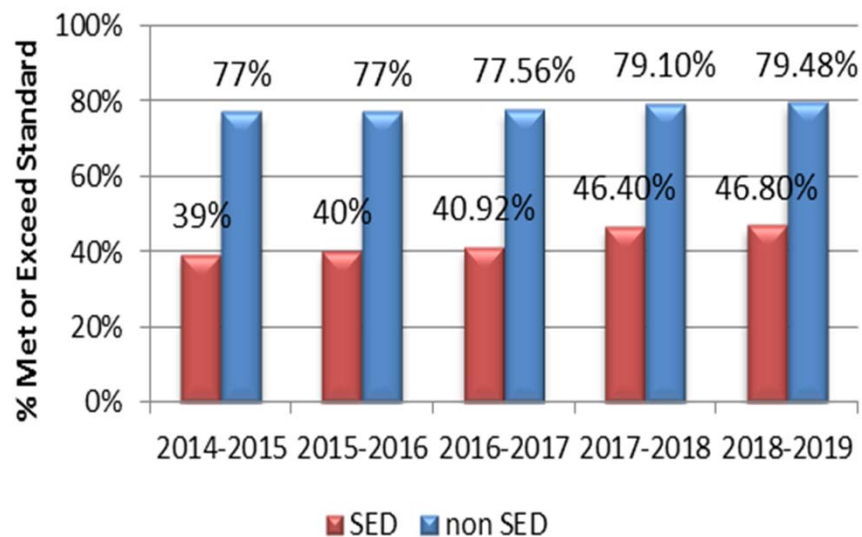

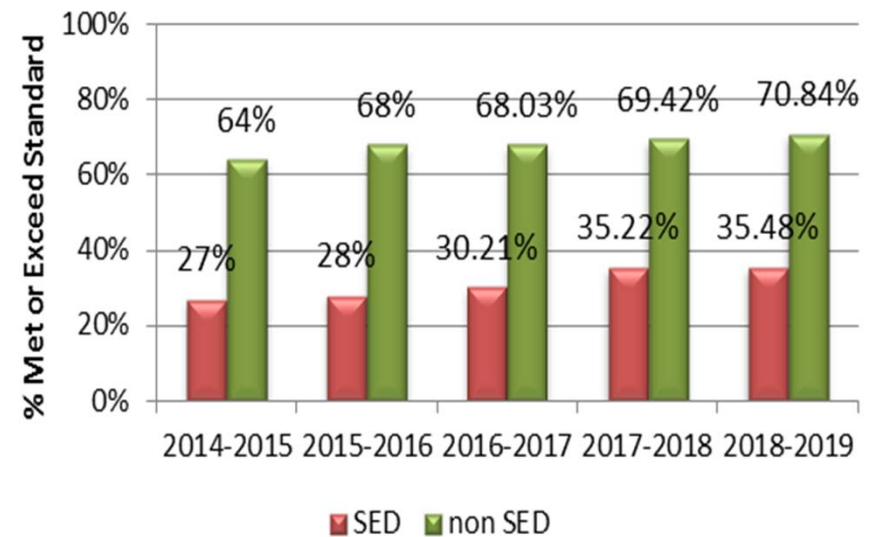

## ELA SBA - SED Comparison

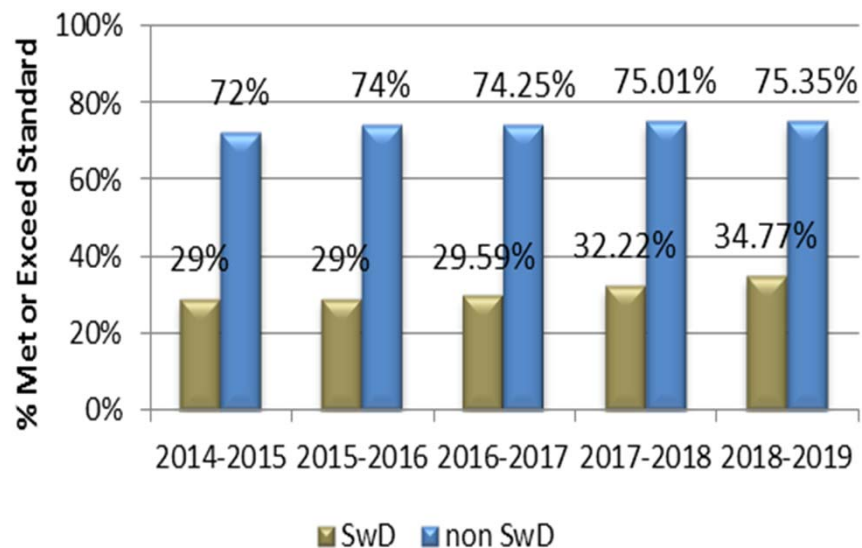


## Math SBA - SED Comparison

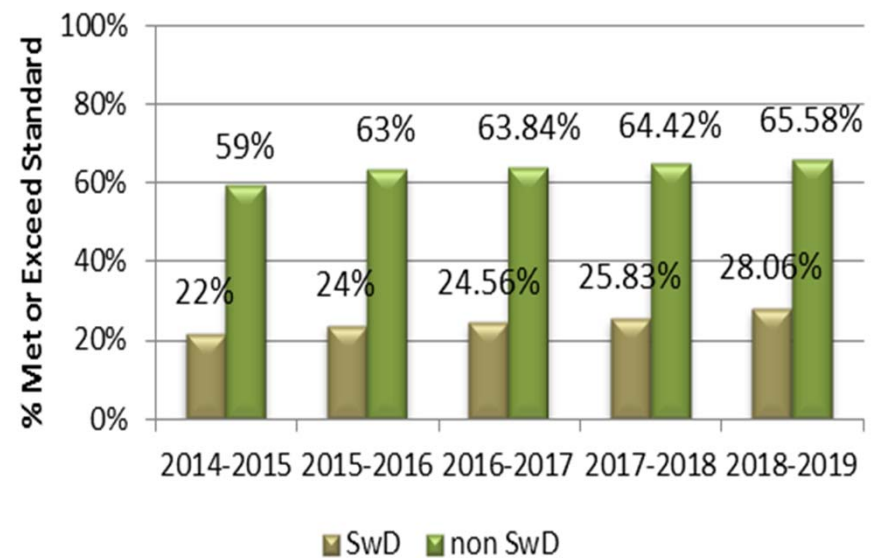

## ELA SBA - SwD Comparison

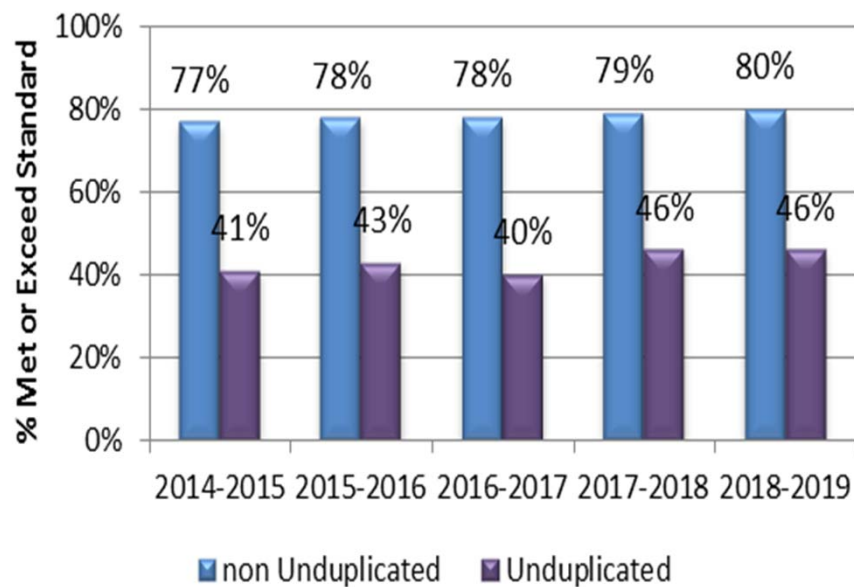

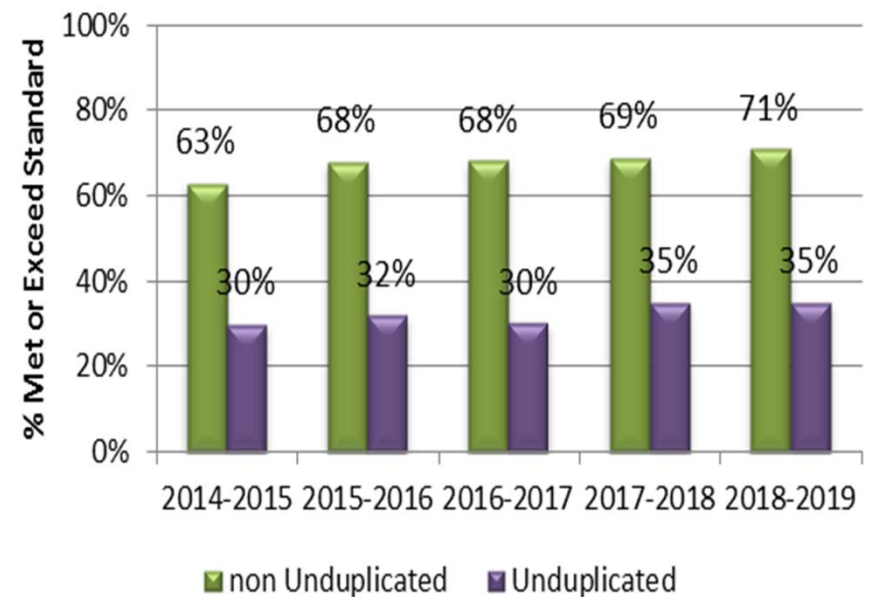

# SBA Cohort Analysis

- Follows students through multiple years as they progress through CUSD
  - For example: follow 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students in 2014-2015 as they become 7<sup>th</sup> grade students in 2018-2019
- Allows us to observe growth on academic standards for one group of students across multiple grade levels

# Next Steps

- Majority of student score reports have been shared through Aeries Parent Portal. Some were mailed home to parents without portal accounts.
- Share results with stakeholders
- Awaiting release of California Alternate Assessment (CAA), California Science Test (CAST), and California Spanish Assessment (CSA) results. State will release in December/January.
- Continue to reach out to other high performing districts to learn from one another.
- Analyze benchmark data – iReady (elementary), CIA (secondary)
