

COMMENDATIONS AND AWARDS

The Governing Board wishes to recognize significant contributions made by employees and citizens which improve the quality of education for District students. To accomplish this, the Board establishes the "EDUCARE AWARD." The "EDUCARE" Award will be a plaque which will be presented to recipients at a regular meeting of the Board.

The "Educare Award" may be given to employees and citizens who:

1. Propose procedures or ideas which thereafter are adopted and effectuated by the Board, and which result in eliminating or reducing District expenditures or improving operations; or
2. Perform special acts or services in the public interest; or
3. By their superior accomplishments, make exceptional contributions to the efficiency, economy or other improvement in operations of the District.

Anyone desiring to nominate an individual to receive an "Educare Award" may do so by completing an application form which may be obtained through the Superintendent. Nominations will be reviewed by the District administrative cabinet, which will recommend to the Superintendent names of individuals to receive an "Educare Award."

The Superintendent shall submit to the Board, for their approval, the name of any individual recommended by the administrative cabinet to receive an "Educare Award."

An annual budget appropriation shall be established to provide funds to pay costs that may be associated with the "Educare" Award plaque and presentation.
