

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS

When a school administrator or supervisor is stricken by accident, illness or death, and the Superintendent believes the activity for which he/she is responsible may be endangered for lack of direction and/or supervision, the Superintendent is authorized to make an "acting" appointment to ensure the uninterrupted continuation of the activity, the appointment to be subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees at its next meeting.

The Superintendent is also authorized to set in motion the usual screening procedure following in the selection of personnel when the "acting" appointment is made to the death of an administrator or supervisor, or due to an accident or illness which the attending physician reports will keep the employee from performing his/her duties for 40 working days or more.
