Innovative Funding Alternatives

Because present funding formulas do not provide adequate support for retooling education for the 21st century, the Board shall pursue funding alternatives for the District's educational program.

In order to support the modernization and enrichment of the educational programs, while meeting the basic classroom needs to support a growing, increasingly diverse student population, the Board believes the District must aggressively pursue alternative resources and funding potentials to augment state allocations.

The Superintendent or designee shall investigate alternative funding sources, including competitive state, federal and private sector grants, as well as assistance from foundations and private endowments.
