

CERTIFICATION

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that persons employed in positions requiring certification qualifications have the appropriate credential or permit authorizing their employment in such positions.

When fully credentialed individuals are not available, the District may employ persons with a Short Term Staff Permit or a Provisional Internship Permit in accordance with law.

The District will facilitate and support the professional development of persons with a Short Term Staff Permit or a Provisional Internship Permit so that they may become fully qualified teachers. The Superintendent or designee shall develop a plan which meets the requirements of law.
