The District shall hire only citizens and residents who are lawfully authorized to work in the United States. District employment practices shall neither favor nor discriminate on the basis of citizenship status or national origin, nor shall they discriminate against any refugees, grantees of asylum, or persons qualified for permanent or temporary residency.

All new employees shall show appropriate documents which certify that they are legally eligible to work in the United States, as required by law.
