

**TEACHING ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS**

K-12 teachers may be asked to participate in leadership activities, as approved by the Principal. These positions shall be designated Teaching Assistant Principal. Teachers who participate in this program shall be compensated at their annual salary as a classroom teacher and shall receive an annual stipend. Teaching Assistant Principals may be asked to serve in administrator designee roles that do not require an administrative credential. Examples include, but are not limited to, supervision, creating supervision schedules, student discipline, SST coordination, and 504 coordination.

Teaching Assistant Principals shall remain in the Capistrano Unified Educators Association (CUEA). Teaching Assistant Principals are not required to possess an administrative credential and shall not evaluate teachers. Teaching Assistant Principals shall retain the work year of regular teachers.
