RESIGNATION

The Superintendent or designee is authorized to accept the written resignation of any employee on behalf of the Governing Board, and the resignation shall become effective immediately upon acceptance by the Superintendent or designee. Alternatively, the employee and the Superintendent or designee may agree that the resignation will be accepted at a mutually agreed upon date not later than two years beyond the close of the school year during which the resignation is received.

If a certificated employee leaves the employ of the District during the school year without obtaining acceptance of his/her resignation, or leaves before the effective date of the resignation, the Superintendent or designee is directed to report this fact, with supporting evidence, to the Commission on Teacher Credentialing. The Commission may suspend the credentials of teachers who leave the District in this manner.
