## Instruction

## STUDENT SUCCESS TEAMS

The Board of Trustees encourages the cooperation of the parent/guardian, classroom teacher, counselor, site Student Success Team coordinator, administrators and other relevant support staff as needed in studying the needs of students having academic, attendance, behavioral or social-emotional difficulties, and in identifying strategies and programs that may assist students on an individualized basis.. The Board expects that student success teams shall be convened, as needed, to address individual students' needs.

The Superintendent or designee shall establish a process for initiating referrals of students to the student success team.

Each student success team shall develop and document intervention strategies to assist the student. Such strategies may include family involvement methods, academic, behavioral and social-emotional interventions, referrals to other agencies or resources, school site collaboration strategies, and/or other appropriate interventions and supports.

The student success team shall monitor the student's progress, collect data to evaluate the efficacy of the recommended strategies/supports, and develop additional interventions as needed. Each team time the team meets, they shall agree upon a timeframe to re-meet to review and revise the course of action, as necessary, to effectuate student success.
