AUDIOVISUAL MATERIALS

The Governing Board believes that textbooks should not serve as the sole instructional resource available to teachers. Teachers are encouraged to incorporate the use of audio-visual materials to enhance, explain, clarify, and/or illustrate concepts within the District's approved curriculum.

Audiovisual materials may include, but not be limited to, 8mm or 16mm films, filmstrips, slides, videotapes, laserdiscs, CD-ROM, CD-I, DVD, live programming, satellite, or cable. Use of any audiovisual materials shall follow the District's copyright policy and the Fair Use Guidelines established by the Motion Picture Association of America Ratings System (MPAA).
