Instruction BP 6159.4

BEHAVIORAL INTERVENTIONS

When a special education student's behavior is inappropriate, staff shall use behavioral interventions that respect the student's dignity and privacy. Such interventions shall be identified in a written Behavioral Plan developed for the student in accordance with law and SELPA procedures. A student may be placed in an interim alternative placement without parental permission for 45 days when the student has been recommended for expulsion in a case involving drugs or weapons.

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that staff clearly understand what behavioral and emergency interventions can and cannot be used.
