RESOLUTION NO. 2021-50
GRANTING SENIORS A DISTRICT DIPLOMA

WHEREAS, Board Policy 6146.1, *High School Graduation Requirements* (c) states that in order “to participate in a graduation ceremony and receive a diploma from a District comprehensive high school, a student must be enrolled prior to the first day of the spring semester. These students must successfully complete 25 District credits.” Currently, there are eight students who moved into District attendance boundaries after the first day of the spring semester and now has no mechanism to either participate in a graduation ceremony or receive a diploma. To resolve this situation, staff proposes to present this resolution which will allow the student listed in the resolution granted the opportunity to participate in the graduation ceremony and receive a diploma provided they meet the 25 District credit requirement.


