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Dear Parent or Guardian of a Grade 7, 9 or 11 Student,

This January, Capistrano Unified School District will be asking students in grades 5, 7, 9 and 11 to participate in a student health and well-being survey sponsored by the California Department of Education. This very important survey helps promote better youth health and well-being, improves the school learning environment and better equips our schools to combat problems such as drug abuse and violence. We are asking Parents/Guardians to complete a parent survey as well as an opportunity to share your opinions about your student's school experience.

The District will provide two parent presentations in a Zoom Meeting <https://capousd-org.zoom.us/j/84099795692> January 11 at 9:00am – 10:00am and January 12 at 6:00pm – 7:00pm. These presentations are for parents who desire more information about the survey and want to understand how the information is being used.

Survey Content: The surveys gather information on developmental support provided to youth; perceived sexual orientation and gender identity; school connectedness and barriers to learning, school safety, health-related concerns such as physical activity and nutritional habits; alcohol, tobacco and other drug use; and risk of depression and suicide. It is Voluntary: Your student is not required to take the survey. If you do not want your student to complete the survey, you must notify your school. Your student will not be penalized or discriminated against in any way for opting out of this survey. Students that do participate do not have to answer any questions they do not want to answer and may stop taking the survey at any time.

It is Anonymous: No names are recorded or attached to the survey forms or data.

Administration: The student survey will be administered between January 18 and February 10, 2022. It takes about 45 minutes to complete and will be administered in one of your student's class periods. To access the Parent Survey, on January 13, 2022, go to <https://tinyurl.com/sdgte7b> and click on your student's school. A follow up email will be sent to all parents with the Parent Survey link. The link will remain open until February 10 and should take about 20 minutes to complete. Paper copies of the surveys are available at your student's school.
