



Launching Your University of California Application


Congratulations on being ready to start your University of California application. You worked hard to get here, and this is a major step in achieving your college and career goals.

By launching your application through CaliforniaColleges.edu, you and your counselor can track your UC application and verify that it has been submitted.

- Once you are signed in to your CaliforniaColleges.edu account, the fastest
 way to launch your application is to hover over College in the top menu bar,
 and select University of California Application.
- In the box that appears, click Confirm to link your CaliforniaColleges.edu
 account to your University of California application account. This will allow
 you to track your application status using your My College Plan.
- Once you have arrived at the University of California application website, you will need to create a new account. Your California Colleges.edu account cannot be linked to an existing University of California application account.
- Once you have created your new University of California application account, you can continue on to fill out your application.
- You can save your application at any time, and use your University of California application account to pick up where you left off.

- For each undergraduate UC campus you've applied to or favorited, you will see one of five statuses:
 - Account created but campus not selected means you have started the
 UC application process, but you have not yet selected any campuses.
 - In progress means you have started your UC application and selected that campus as one to which you will apply.
 - In progress but campus not selected means you have started your UC application, but you did not select that campus in your application.
 - Submitted means you have submitted your UC application to that campus.
 - Submitted but campus not selected means you have submitted your
 UC application, but you did not select that campus.
