How We Help

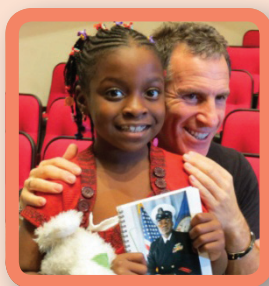
The Bringing Families Back Together Program provides strategies to support resilience during all phases of the deployment cycle.

When the family member is scheduled for deployment CCMK will deliver *With You All the Way! Dealing With Deployment*. This is a comprehensive set of resources that guides families as they prepare for a deployment, includes activities to stay connected during deployment, and helps plan for their family member to return home.

When a family member returns, CCMK will deliver the follow up resource, *Together Again! Helping Military Families Reconnect*. For many families, reintegration is even more challenging than the deployment. This set of resources focuses on the unique challenges families experience during the reintegration phase of the deployment cycle.
