What is Distance Learning during Closure in regards to my child's IEP services?

During Distance Learning, the District will make available specialized distance learning services, which are temporary services until regular instruction at school sites resume. When both statewide and county shelter-in-place orders are rescinded and regular instruction at school sites resume, the services reflected in the IEP's service grid will again be made available at your child's school. On a computer

1. On your computer, go to hangouts.google.com or open Hangouts in [Gmail](https://gmail.com). If you have the Hangouts Chrome extension, Hangouts will open in a new window.
2. At the top, click New conversation .
3. Enter and select a name or email address.
4. Type your message. You can also add emojis and photos.
5. On your keyboard, press Enter.

On an Android Phone/Tablet

1. On your Android phone or tablet, open the Hangouts app .
2. At the bottom right, tap Add  > New Conversation .
3. Type and select a person's name.
4. Enter your message. You can also add emojis, photos, or a sticker.
5. Tap Send .

On an iPhone/iPad

1. On your iPhone or iPad, open the Hangouts app .
2. At the bottom right, tap Add .
3. Type and select a person's name.
4. Enter your message. You can also add emojis, photos, or a sticker.
5. Tap Send .
