
**Continued Learning for
Adult and Special
Services
(CLASS)**

Program Description

CLASS is a Post-Secondary program that serves students who have an IEP, who have finished 4 years of High School, and did not obtain a High School Diploma.

Typically students attend for 1 to 3 hours a week through appointments. Students work directly with CLASS staff individually, or in group activities.

CLASS offers support for Certificate Track and Diploma Track students.



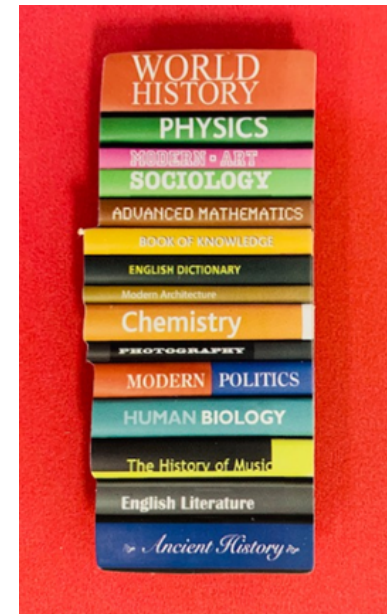

Student Outcomes in CLASS are based on individual needs and include the following:

High School Diploma

Direct, individualized instruction is provided in all courses required for graduation. Instruction provided in a one-on-one setting, independent study with additional support as needed. Students have the option of participating in end of the year graduation ceremony, once eligible.

Employment Related Social Skills

Sessions provide students with social and communications skills to help them succeed in searching for and obtaining a job. Skills are tailored to the individual goals and circumstances of each student.

Classroom instruction for work skills include the following activities for obtaining and maintaining employment:

- Job application preparation
- Interview techniques / mock interviews
- Resume development
- Career exploration, appropriate for various jobs
- Work behaviors and expectations skills
- Grooming and hygiene
- Job search

The priority of the program is to help students increase their self-esteem and provided skills they require to gain and retain employment.



High School Equivalency

- Develop plan for successful completion of high school equivalency testing
- Provide assistance with remediation, preparation and registration for testing
- Provide support with applying for testing accommodations, if needed and desired
- Provide practice testing opportunities
- Provide individualized, direct instruction as needed



Continued Academic Support for Certificate/Diploma Track Students

- Provide academic enrichment
- Provide vocational skills
- Provide direct instruction in areas of need
- Monitor/assist with classes at community college or other post-secondary settings
